







Lion

In 1992 and 1993, pioneering reintroduction methods were successfully used to mix Phinda's first 13 lions sourced from different prides.

Cheetah

The reintroduction of Namibian cheetah - 12 in two groups - was carefully planned to give them time to settle before lion were introduced - the first successful reintroduction of these two species into the same area.

Elephant

Phinda was the first private reserve to reintroduce elephants in 1991. The initial two intakes of elephant were 37 orphaned youngsters, with the first four adults arriving from Zimbabwe in 1993.

Rhino

21 white rhino - an estimated 35 tons - were relocated in one day from a neighbouring farm in the largest translocation of its time.
