




Showcase culture through our lodge's design and construction, spanning from guest accommodations to communal spaces











Activities tailored to engage guests in Mongolian culture, such as constructing a ger, horseback riding, or practicing archery




# **Cultural Heritage Preservation and Celebration: Our Ongoing Mission**
